

One at a Time: The Life, Passion, and Ongoing Global Impact of Larry Ward

Reprinted Biography of Food for the Hungry Founder Inspires Action to End Poverty

Do you long to change the world for the better? Want to keep vulnerable children from suffering, but aren't sure how to go about it? PHOENIX (August 12, 2015) – *“But Father,” he prayed, “what can I do? I’m just one person...” An answer that was audible only to the ears of his heart struck him as clear as a bell: “But they die one at a time, my son, they die one at a time.” Larry [Ward] slowed his car, pulled over to the curb of Franklin Boulevard, and stopped. With his head bent over the steering wheel he prayed. “Thank you, Lord. If they die one at a time, then we can help them one at a time.”*

In the 1980s, a book was published chronicling the life of [Food for the Hungry](#) founder Larry Ward. Now, more than four decades after this organization was founded, a new edition of the biography, *One at a Time: The Life, Passion, and Ongoing Global Impact of Larry Ward* is available for download as an e-book and will be released in print by the end of August.

“Our team was given the extraordinary privilege of bringing back to life a book long out-of-print but containing a story that still lives strong,” said Shannon Litton, an editor of the new edition of *One at a Time*. “It’s the biography of a man many would later call ‘an Indiana Jones of compassion and faith.’”

“As we read, wrote, edited, updated and repackaged, a new light was cast on the commitment and gritty determination of the work today done by Food for the Hungry,” said Litton. “The early days weren’t easy. The hard places were hard. The problems seemed overwhelming. But the mission was clear.”
